1. "B" average in academics and behavior.

3. Speech should not promise things, i.e. bring back free dress for Jr. High on Fridays; no school on Mondays. **Discuss your qualifications for the specific position.**
4. Campaign posters should be no bigger than a sliding glass door. They are to be student generated; using only the kinds of materials that one would find at school. Materials might be: poster paints, markers, crayons, glitter, etc. Computer generated posters can be used, but printed at home only. **No extra expense is to be incurred.**
5. Candidates are to wear "Sunday" best on Election Day. Campaign managers wear school uniforms. Bring suitable shoes to change into for PE.

Mrs. Ibsen will be helping with speeches from May 13-19 at first recess and lunch recess. Finalized speeches are due for Mrs. Ibsen's approval by May 18th.
